a. Reports of Officers

i. Master

Started the year with a focus on recruitment- article in the ringing world, fresher fair and hosted the miniring outside the DSU. Approximately 6-8 new ringers, and we are having weekly beginners' practices before usual session.

Three quarter peals so far including members of DUSCR- Yorkshire and 2x Bob Doubles.

Regular practices including a wide variety including Rounds and Calls, Bob Doubles, Cambridge and Norwich. We have also had additional sessions to develop other skills, such as learning how to teach and how to call. Once again we are very grateful to be supported by Jean and Keith, who really help to expand the experience of the band.

Many members attended the Shincliffe tour, which was a brilliant day- a chance to get more experience and more towers.

A Cathedral session took place for evensong on Sunday 22nd October, and we will be ringing for Founders and Benefactors on 26th November

We also had a social in the form of a games night on Thursday, well attended and a good night was had by all.

ii. Treasurer

DSU haven't sent a finance report in a few months, but I believe there's approximately £360 in the account. Roughly what it was went I started two years ago.

Since last meeting, have paid to get hand bells repaired. Kindly done by Chris Crabtree.

Applied for the DSU Ordinary grant. Applied for £800 for accommodation and £100 for Tower donations for the summer tour. We received £800 for the accommodation. Roughly £300 more than we received last year!

This money should be used by the next master to subsidise tour costs.

We also received the ART teaching award £250. We plan to put the money towards a new bell model, teaching resources and to cover taxi costs for the first term. This should leave around £100 for the summer tour.

This term we've spent £45 on taxis, and averaged practise costs at £1/person/practice. With the ART grant, this should reduce the costs to 30p/person/practice.

So far we have 7 paid members. Everyone that hasn't paid should do so when they have the time/money. It's important as the money goes towards Sunday transport!

iii. Webmaster

Kept the website up to date by adding new pictures and some new information about events.

I've also changed the structure of the site slightly, as it was a little confusing.
